

Näbb Armchair

Design Mattias Stenberg

The simple combination of leather and steel create a striking chair with an understated character. Näbb resembles a streamlined club chair, and offers the same level of comfort. The seat and backrest are made from a leather sheath suspended from the steel frame, which overlaps at the top and is stitched in place. The leather pieces are sourced from Tärnsjö Garveri and can be complemented by fabric panels attached to the chair's back and sides.

Materials and surface treatments

All metal parts are powder-coated steel in black Noir 2200 Sablé or light gray RAL 7044. Leather in seat i black or light brown. Textiles on the outside of seat.

Stee

Nola uses high-quality steel with good strength in our products. Steel rusts if left untreated and must therefore be surface treated.

Powder coating

Powder coating is a coating that is applied as a free-flowing, dry powder. Unlike conventional liquid paint, powder coating is usually applied electrostatically and then cured under heat or with ultraviolet light. The result is an even, hard-wearing coloured surface with the desired gloss level.

Assembly and placement

Freestanding

Freestanding product that is placed directly on the ground.

Requires no installation.

Maintenance Powdercoated steel

Products that are powder-coated can be touch-up painted with alkyd paint.
