Materials and surface treatments	Concrete. Concrete Concrete is cement mixed with crushed stone or aggregate. The material is very strong in compression but fragile in tension. To compensate for this concrete can be reinforced, often with steel. Coloured concrete Colored concrete is concrete in a color other than standard grey. Pigment is added to the dry mixture, which means that the concrete becomes coloured throughout. Each color has its own recipe.
Assembly and placement	Surface mountCan be bolted above ground, to the floor or to a cast-in-place foundation. Bolts not included.Fully assembled and ready to be bolted to the ground. Due to its heavy weight, the bollard is delivered secured to a wooden pallet.One M16 bolt is required to secure the bollard to the ground. The bolt is included.
