Milan Planter and Brazier

Milan is a multi-functional outdoor design. In the summer, it can be used as a planter for flowers, ornamental shrubs and trailing vines. When winter comes, it functions as a brazier for an outdoor fire. Milan's robust construction creates a strong, stable base, and its steel structure is completely fireproof. The brazier can hold charcoal as well as firewood, providing heat and light when needed outdoors.

Materials and surface treatments	<p>The frame is made from steel treated with anti-corrosion oil. The bowl is made from 3 mm sheet steel. The inner container is made from fibreglass appr 2 mm - 3 mm thick.</p> <p>Steel</p> <p>Nola uses high-quality steel with good strength in our products. Steel rusts if left untreated and must therefore be surface treated.</p> <p>Plastic / Fiberglass</p> <p>Glass fiber is often used as reinforcement in plastics to increase rigidity by coating a glass fiber fabric with a plastic, usually a polyester, which hardens and binds the glass fiber together.</p>
Assembly and placement	<p>Surface mount</p> <p>Can be bolted above ground, to the floor or to a cast-in-place foundation. Bolts not included.</p> <p>Fully assembled.</p>
Maintenance	<p>Routine maintenance is not required, but the frame will benefit from being coated with anti-corrosion oil annually.</p> <p><u>Read more in our general maintenance advice at nola.se/en/care-and-maintenance</u></p>
Versions	<p>The product can be used as a planter or a brazier.</p>
