Materials and surface treatments	Steel Nola uses high-quality steel with good strength in our products. Steel rusts if left untreated and must therefore be surface treated. Powder coating Powder coating is a coating that is applied as a free-flowing, dry powder. Unlike conventional liquid paint, powder coating is usually applied electrostatically and then cured under heat or with ultraviolet light. The result is an even, hard-wearing coloured surface with the desired gloss level. Hot-dip galvanizing provides very strong protection against corrosion. The steel is dipped into a bath of hot liquid zinc. The zinc attaches and creates a surface coating on the steel part, which is then taken out of the bath and drained of excess zinc.
Assembly and placement	Freestanding Freestanding product that is placed directly on the ground. Surface mount Can be bolted above ground, to the floor or to a cast-in-place foundation. Bolts not included. Fully assembled.
