Piccolo Coat Rack and Umbrella Holder

Piccolo is a freestanding unit where coats can be hung. Piccolo is made with a central post fitted with two tiers of hooks, eliminating the need for coat hangers. Umbrellas can be stored in the matching umbrella stand, crafted with a leak-resistant base lined with water-absorbent fibres. Paired together, both designs make a stylish addition to hallways and reception areas. For indoor use only.

Dimensions and weight

Coat rack: Ø: 45 cm. Height: 176 cm. Weight: 18 kg.

Umbrella holder: Ø: 34,4 cm. Height: 80 cm. Weight: 7 kg.

Individual dimensions

Coat rack: 27 mm steel pipe and 5 mm flat steel with hangers in wire with a

diameter of 5-7 mm.

Umbrella holder: 25 mm Solid bar and 5 mm flat steel.

Materials and surface treatments

Steel

Nola uses high-quality steel with good strength in our products. Steel rusts if left untreated and must therefore be surface treated.

Powder coating

Powder coating is a coating that is applied as a free-flowing, dry powder. Unlike conventional liquid paint, powder coating is usually applied electrostatically and then cured under heat or with ultraviolet light. The result is an even, hard-wearing coloured surface with the desired gloss level.

Assembly and placement

Freestanding

Freestanding product that is placed directly on the ground.

Both products are freestanding.

Maintenance

Powdercoated steel

Products that are powder-coated can be touch-up painted with alkyd paint.
